### Med Dispense

Med Dispense's automated dispensing cabinet (ADC) is a computerized drug-storage device that controls and documents the dispensing of patient medications, offering 24/7 access to prescribed medications even when a pharmacist is not available. In addition to its durable cabinet, *medDISPENSE* is known for its industry-leading, intuitive software interface that incorporates many features to ensure patient safety.

### Dry Cleaning Service

HVCH and Wyman Cleaners have teamed together to offer employees a new service.

- 1.) HVCH employees will receive a 15% discount when using Wyman Cleaners.
- 2.) Pick up a Wyman's clothing bag, for your dirty clothes and drop off to HR on Mondays (no later than 3:00 pm). Large items like quilts and clothing that needs to be altered must be dropped off at Wyman Cleaners, 65 E. Main St. in Logan. Their phone number is 385-9194. Wyman Cleaners hours are M-F, 7:30 am to 5:30 pm., Saturday, 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.
- 3.) The employee will sign a blank form authorizing payroll deduction to cover the cost. They will also complete the card attached to the bag so Wyman Cleaners will know who the clothing articles belong. The employee will agree to have the cost deducted in one pay.
- 4.) Wyman Cleaners will send HVCH a billon a monthly basis and Sheri Thompson will apply to payroll deduction.
- 5.) Employees can pick up their completed order at Wyman Cleaners on Thursday, anytime after 3:30 pm.
