Carter Hodson. His journey to get here has been a long and winding one. He made the decision in January of 2019 that he wanted to pursue this path. With the full support of his family he enlisted on August 1, 2019.

He was ready to leave for boot camp and wanted to do so as soon as possible. That date didn't come around until May 26, 2020. For a young, 20-year old, the wait felt like an eternity. Nothing about his initial military experience was what he thought it would be. From the delayed enlistment, to a delayed deployment to BMT (Basic Military Training) to the experience when he arrived in San Antonio, things have been "different."

He was quarantined for 14-days upon his arrival; their training was slightly modified in order to protect those on base, and sadly, none of us were allowed to travel to the base to participate in his coining and graduation ceremonies. In remembering Madison's

graduation several years ago, there was so much energy and excitement at those ceremonies. Thankfully, due to technology, we were able to watch his graduation via a live Facebook feed. Although exciting and emotional still, we wanted to be there for him when he walked out of that Pavilion.

This young man has been patient and has succeeded at all that he's done. He was just shy of expert marksmanship and scored a 99% on his physical fitness test. - **15.** Is visitation allowed? We understand the importance of having friends and family included in the healing process. Early in our response efforts, we minimized the number of visitors a patient could have and then ultimately suspended all visitation to ensure patients and staff were protected from the possibility of contracting the virus. As we move through the continued response and recovery phases of the pandemic, we will monitor what best practices are being shared with regards to allowing visitation always keeping the focus on the health and safety of patients and staff.
- **16.** Are there enough PPE supplies to keep me and my family safe? Hocking Valley Community Hospital monitors the amount of personal protective supplies that we have in stock. In addition to ordering from regular supply chains, we have received supplies from a national stockpile. We have also received generous donations of homemade masks from people both from and outside of the community, and we continue to accept these donations as we move through the next phase of this pandemic.
