The one-mile marked walking trail on HVCH campus is open year-round for guests and their pets to enjoy. You can even stop at our stretching and exercise stations to add to your workout!

Walking is one of the easiest ways to get the exercise you need to stay healthy.

Experts recommend at least 2½ hours of moderate activity (such as brisk walking, brisk cycling, or yard work) a week. It's fine to walk in blocks of 10 minutes or more throughout your day and week.

- If you're worried about how brisk walking might affect your health, talk with your doctor before you start a walking program.
- Start with a short-term goal. For example, walk for 5 or 10 minutes every day. Or increase your number of steps by 300 to 500 each day.
- After you've made walking a habit, set a longer-term goal. You may want to set a goal of walking briskly for at least

30 minutes a day or work up to 10,000 steps a day. You can try to do this 5 days a week or more.

- To stay motivated, find a walking partner, such as a family member, friend, or coworker. Daily dog walks are also a great way to keep up your walking routine.
 - Schedule walks on your calendar.
- Use a phone app or buy a pedometer. They count how many steps you take. The first time you use it, count how many steps you normally take in a day. Track your activity every day, and set a goal for increasing the number of steps.
- Instead of watching TV or going out to eat, go out for a walk.
 - At work, get up and move around

 - Carry a cell phone for emergencies.
 - Wear comfortable shoes and socks that cushion your feet.
- Pay attention to your walking surface. Use sidewalks and paths.
- If you usually walk outside and the weather is bad, take comfortable shoes to the mall and walk several laps inside.
- Drink plenty of water before, during, and after you are active. This is very important when it's hot out.

RUGER .450 Bushmaster American Rifle Ranch

The new Ruger .450 Bushmaster American Rifle Ranch is the third member of the American bolt-action line designed to fire AR-15 semi-automatic cartridges, including models chambered for the .223 Rem. and .300 Blackout. The 16.12" cold-hammer-forged barrel is free-floated and has a muzzle threaded at 11/16-24 TPI. The muzzle is then fitted at the factory with a specially designed muzzle brake secured by an adjustable barrel nut in place of a crush washer. The steel receiver is topped with a factory-installed 5" aluminum optics rail compatible with Picatinny-type scope mounting systems. The single-piece, three-lug bolt cycles smoothly and features a full diameter bolt body, dual cocking cams and a round knob bolt handle.
